#### **Auction Notification**

SIDHartA Auctioneer is an official auction that is monitored by the Office of Auctions of the Direktorat Jendral Kekayaan Negara Indonesia . An Auction Registrar, Chitra Mukhsin is present on behalf of the Office of Auctions to monitor that the auction is run properly, provide an official report to the government and ensure that the winning bidders comply with their part, ie make payment in full and in due time.

This auction is a regular Continental Style auction. Bidders bid the lots they desire until the highest bid is reached. There is a 22% buyer's premium charged on top of hammer price that is to be paid by the winning bidder in addition to the hammer price itself.

You will find the lots to be auctioned in sequence, starting from the lowest number to the highest number. Live online auction usually goes at a rate of 119 lots perhour. 80 lots should take around 2 hour, 22 minutes.

The estimate price of the lot reflects roughly the current price of the artworks, meaning in normal circumstances, a bidder placing a bid within the range of the estimate should be able to win the lot, unless there is unusual competition. However, depending on demand, a bidder may also be able to win the lot at a price either lower than the low estimate (at the reserve price), or even win the piece at a price higher than the high estimate.

Most of the lots do have a reserve, a minimum limit price at which the owner/vendor of the lot agrees to let go of the lot. Auctioneer is allowed to execute bidding up to the reserve, on behalf of the owner/vendor of the lot. That is what is going on when bidding has started, and the Auctioneer counters the bid by saying that a bid of a certain lot is still "with me". Until bidding reaches the reserve, a lot cannot be considered sold. So a lot is only considered sold if it has already reached the reserve.

Bidding does not stop only until the reserve is reached, but it continues until the highest bid has been reached and the auctioneer will count up to three to make sure that there are no more bids. The Auctioneer will strike the hammer strike is to signify that the lot has been sold and call out the paddle number of the bidder and the hammer price.

We commonly have Written Bids, Phone Bids and Online Bids. Our operators on the phone will execute bids on behalf of the phone bidders who are monitoring the auction via the phone. Absentee Written Bids have also been placed with the Auctioneer and they have been registered in the auction book. Online Bids are executed automatically via the internet.

The Auctioneer will execute the Absentee Bids up to the limit that they have provided, and you will also hear that the absentee bid is "with me", and the Auctioneer will indicate that the bid is a Written Bid that is left by an Absentee bidder. So, bidders on the floor will be also competing with Absentee Bidders who have left their bids with us, phone bidders, and online bidders.

The lot in the auctions are sold as is and condition reports of each lot is available upon request. You should have consulted the works that you want to buy. If there are certain mistakes in the wording of the information of the lots in the catalog, we will put them up in Sale Room Notices.

Certificates: We are not authorized, do not and will not publish certificates. So unless there is mention of certificates in the auction catalog, please do not expect to obtain any certificates from us.

Our office operates from Tuesday to Saturday; therefore, you should receive the invoice inclusive the 22% premium by today or at the latest on Tuesday or Wednesday.

We accept bank transfer and credit card payment, and it is expected to be completed in three days. You may pick up the lots by showing necessary proofs of payment or it can also be delivered at a reasonable extra cost.

## The King On My Toe by Sudigdo

Lot #137

Sudigdo is a prominent Indonesian painter known for his captivating works that blend traditional Indonesian artistry with modern influences. Born in 1943 in Solo, Indonesia, Sudigdo's artistry is deeply rooted in Javanese culture and mythology, which he expertly translates onto canvas.

At first glace, King of My Toe pontificates the role of a King, the chess piece that ultimately decides a victory or a loss. However, it is hardly the most powerful piece on the board. It can be argued that the Queen, which in this case is represented by the lady in red uplifting the piece, is far more versatile and powerful due to the fact that the piece can travel across any tile within the board.

His paintings often feature rich, vibrant colors and intricate detailing, showcasing scenes from Indonesian folklore, everyday life, and nature. His works not only serve as visual masterpieces but also as a means of preserving and celebrating Indonesia's rich cultural heritage.



## Collection of Jacob Vredenbregt (Schiedam, 20 November 1926 - Jakarta, 17 November 2020)


In our auction this time, we feature the collection of Prof Dr Jacob Vredenbregt who had lived in Indonesia for most time of his life, since the 1960s. He was professor of anthropology at the Hasanuddin University in Makassar, South Sulawesi and at the Universitas Indonesia in Depok (1970-1991). Vredenbregt was the representative of Leiden University in Southeast Asia, based in Jakarta from June 1998 to June 2010. He was instrumental in setting up and maintaining academic relations between Indonesia and the Netherlands. The Indonesian Netherlands Co-operation in Islamic Studies (INIS) program of the Projects Division of Leiden University which he initiated was a tremendous success in producing many fellows who became professors and influential people in the Indonesian bureaucracy.

He was also a prolific novelist and author of many other publications in Indonesian, Dutch, and English. Apart from being a scholar, he was an avid collector and his collection of Indonesian art and Chinese porcelain was especially famous.

Among his collection are works on paper by Trubus, Rusli, and Oesman Effendi dating from the 1940s and 1950s, as well as an earlier piece by Dutch artist Marius Bauer (1867 – 1932). He also collected works by Bagong Kussudiardja and Nyoman Gunarsa. Interested in the development of their art, he collected pieces from more than one period of their career.

Vredenbregt"s friendship with S. Hadi Asmara resulted in his commission of the monumental sculpture Men Brayut, currently the collection of Museum Pasifika. The collector also collected some paintings and sculpture by the artist.

Vredenbregt continued to collect until the end of his life, acquiring a piece by Rudolf Schmidt after 1993. In 2001, he was gifted a painting by his old friend Arie Smit, evidenced by an inscription on the verso of the painting: "For Jacob, from Arie" it reads. Albeit brief, it is a testament of the essential friendship of the two men.


## Basoeki Abdullah's Portrait of Djupriany

Lot #162

Basoeki Abdullah was a painter who was particularly famous for his paintings of women. He was known for idealizing and beautifying the female figures he portrayed.

This painting is a unique exception, as it is a painting of a young man. However, it is not of any young man. It is a portrait of Djupriany (1929 - ), the adopted son of painter Ernest Dezentje, who was also a painter. Apparently, it was painted on a sunny day on Sunday, 29 September 1957 at the Bogor Presidential Palace, during a gathering of painters, which was often held by President Sukarno during the time.

It is a portrait of a young man, a fellow artist. It shows that Basoeki Abdullah respected young artists and considered them as his equal. It also shows the spirit of brotherhood among Indonesian artists from that time onwards.



## Bunga Seruni by Gesang Martohartono

Lot #179

**Gesang Martohartono**, born **Soetardi** (Solo, Central Java, 1917 – 2010) was best-known as the composer of the famous *kroncong* song *Bengawan Solo*.

Born in Solo, Central Java, his family plunged into poverty when his father's batik business went bankrupt. Gesang, became a self-taught musician who supported his family by writing songs and singing at weddings and other formal occasions.

Just before the Japanese occupation of the Dutch East Indies in World War II, in 1940 the impoverished 23-year-old musician composed a tune using a flute in the popular urban local style known as *keroncong*, a musical tradition of the region which combined traditional Javanese chord progressions with Westernized instrumental arrangements and melodies which had its origins in 17th century Portuguese cultural influence upon the region.

Gesang had dreamt since my childhood about writing a song of praise for the immortal Solo River. The Bengawan Solo River is Java's longest and most important waterway for trade and agriculture, and to Gesang it symbolized the durability of Javanese culture in those troubled times.

Gesang's Bengawan Solo became widely popular among the local Javanese community, and then gained national prominence when recordings of it were aired on local radio stations. During the Japanese occupation (1942-1945) its simple, nostalgic lyrics and popular-sounding melody found an appreciative audience among the Japanese occupation forces, as well as among the Dutch civilian prisoners of the Japanese internment camps alike.

After Japan's defeat, the returning soldiers of the Japanese Imperial Army brought the song back to Japan. In the dark period that followed, *Bengawan Solo* caught the public mood, and its fame soon spread throughout the country after best-selling recordings were released by popular Japanese singers. The song became synonymous with Indonesian music, with many assuming that it was an ancient, centuries-old, traditional song.

Versions of "Bengawan Solo" were released in other countries, reinterpreted by musical artists worldwide.

Gesang remained in Solo, continuing to compose and sing in humility, although in 1991, a group of appreciative Japanese war veterans arranged for a life-size statue of Gesang to be erected in a park in the city of Solo, to mark their respects for the composer of the tune that had crossed the cultural barriers of wartime.

While he was famous as a composer, he was also an accomplished painter. Apparently, Gesang loved painting since he was young. His parents even advised him to continue to pursue painting. He continued to paint quietly until his old age. This painting, titled *Bunga Seruni (Chrysanthemum)* was done in 2000, when he was 83 years of age. Interestingly, he did not paint the flowers cut in a vase, like other painters normally would. Instead he painted the flowers, growing on the branches of a whole tree, as if he wanted to preserve them while at the same time creating and monumentalizing their beauty and serenity in an aesthetic work of art.






## Igro by of Jeihan Sukmantoro

Lot #217

Jeihan was best known for the black eyes in the figures in his paintings, which initially was a result of his failure in painting eyes realistically. Later, he realized that the black eyes served as a metaphor. Through the black eyes of the figures in his paintings, Jeihan sugges—ts his viewers to always keep an open imagination about the things that could not be reached by the physical reach of humans alone through the open eye and to always look deeper and farther, like the black hole of the universe.

In this painting, he painted something completely different. It shows a sleek metalic curved line, seeming to emerge out of the dark blue and black colors of the painting, which is given the title "lqro" or "lqra". "lqra" is a word of Classical Arabic origin literally signifying an imperative "read/recite" which is believed by Muslims to be the first word revealed to Muhammad in the Quran. "lqra" can be interpreted or translated more broadly to mean: to understand, to analyze, to examine, to study, to research, to know, and so on, which is based in the name of God the almighty creator.

Interestingly, the artist did not use a calligraphic transliteration of "Iqra". Instead, he used more abstract expression, one with which he is more familiar. Can you feel what the painting is commanding or persuading you to do?




Jeihan Sukmantoro I (Solo, C. Java, 1938 - Bandung, W. Java, 2019)


